CTC Captain's Agreement

The Clovis Tennis Club thanks you for captaining or co-captaining a USTA or Intercity team. In the effort to ensure that positive leadership is exhibited by CTC team captains at all times, the CTC has established this captain's agreement, which all captains and co-captains must read, agree to and sign prior to starting a team.

The expectations of all captains, co-captains and team members are that they exhibit personal and team behavior that always reflects sportsmanship and fair play. By being a captain or co-captain, you are responsible not only for your personal behavior but also for leadership that will reflect team behavior. The CTC wants all of its teams to maintain the reputation of being competitive, social and fun to be around. When another team gets beat by a CTC team, the opponents know they have been treated with dignity and respect.

In addition to the general obligation above, here is a list of specific responsibilities that every captain and co-captain must agree to and accept.

- 1. All team members must be current CTC members <u>before</u> they play for the team. Captains and co-captains whose players are not all members will not be allowed to captain, co-captain or participate on another CTC-sponsored team until those membership fees are paid. Membership fees paid late will be retroactive to the start of the team's USTA season.
- 2. The schedule of all home team matches must be coordinated with the CTC executive director.
- **3.** All CTC activities must be self-supporting. Required CTC membership is to offset the general expenses of the organization. These expenses include, but are not limited to, insurance, lights, printing, postage, court improvements (nets/straps) and other membership and association dues. This means that all other team expenses, including balls, are the responsibility of each individual team.
- **4.** Should you or your team be involved in a formal USTA grievance, it is the captain's responsibility to forward a copy of that grievance to the CTC board chairperson for review.
- 5. Beverages and food may be supplied to team members, and they are encouraged to be shared with opponents' team members. Absolutely NO alcohol-containing beverages shall be consumed, carried or displayed on CUSD grounds. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule!
